3D Policy

- The printer may only be used for lawful purposes and be for objects appropriate for a public library environment.
- Objects must not infringe upon any third party's intellectual property rights.
- Objects must not be illegal, nor can they be construed as having the intent to harm.
- The Library reserves the right to refuse any print request at the discretion of library staff.
- The Library will not save or retain submitted files after printing objects.
- Staff will not modify or change models once submitted.
- The patron is responsible for the cost of the 3D print even if the print job is unsuccessful.

Getting Started

- Bring your .STL file in on a flash drive.
- Staff will review the file, provide an estimated cost, and prepare your print job.
- The Library will not print objects with an estimated print time of more than 6.5 hours.
- Cost is 15 cents per gram of plastic with a \$1.50 minimum.
- Once your object is completed, we will contact you to pick it up.
- Objects will be held for 7 days for pick up.

Tech Notes

- Maximum size is 9-inch x 9-inch x 9-inch.
- Material: ABS plastic filament.
- Printers: Polyprinter 229.
- Objects print in a single color.
- Objects printed should not be subjected to high heat or stress.
- Objects printed are not food safe and should not be used to store or prepare food.

The use of the printed object upon completion is not under the direction or control of the Library. The Denison Public Library is not liable for injuries, property damage, or failure of function caused by objects or materials made through the utilization of our 3D printers.
