TCEQ Sanitary Sewer Overflow Projects

PROJECT OVERVIEW In years past, the City developed a Sanitary Sewer Overflow Initiative (SSOI) and entered an agreement with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to repair and/or replace sanitary sewer facilities that historically overflow during times of increased flow. Though many of these projects have been completed, a number are still outstanding. It is anticipated that all the projects outlined in the City's SSOI will be completed by the end of 2018, thus, fulfilling the agreement with TCEQ.
