2017-2019 Water Line Improvements

PLAN OVERVIEW The 2017-2019 Water Line Capital Improvement Plan consists of replacing five deteriorated water lines in a number of locations throughout the City. These projects are prioritized by the existing water line condition, frequency of failure, and coordination with the Pavement Management Plan. One of the goals of the Plan is to increase the water pressures and water quality throughout the City by replacing the older cast iron water lines with new polyvinyl chloride (PVC) water lines.

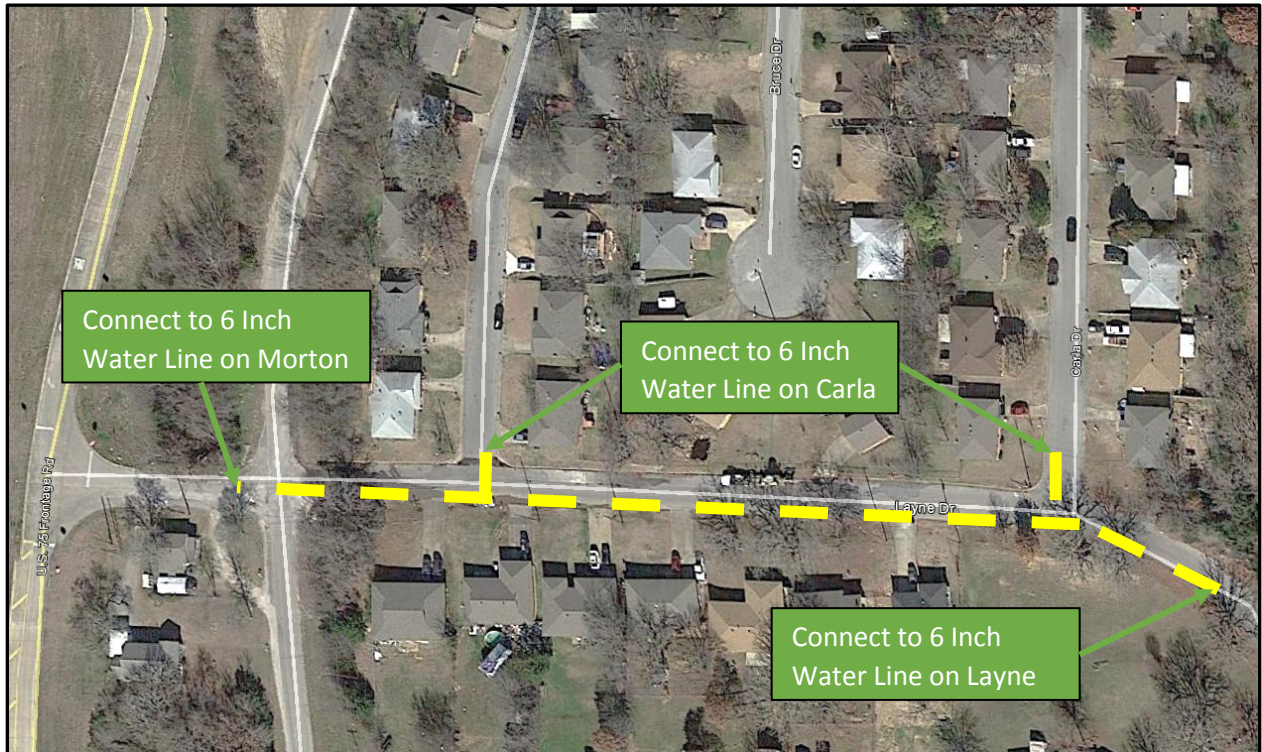
EAST HERON WATER LINE (Houston to 6th)



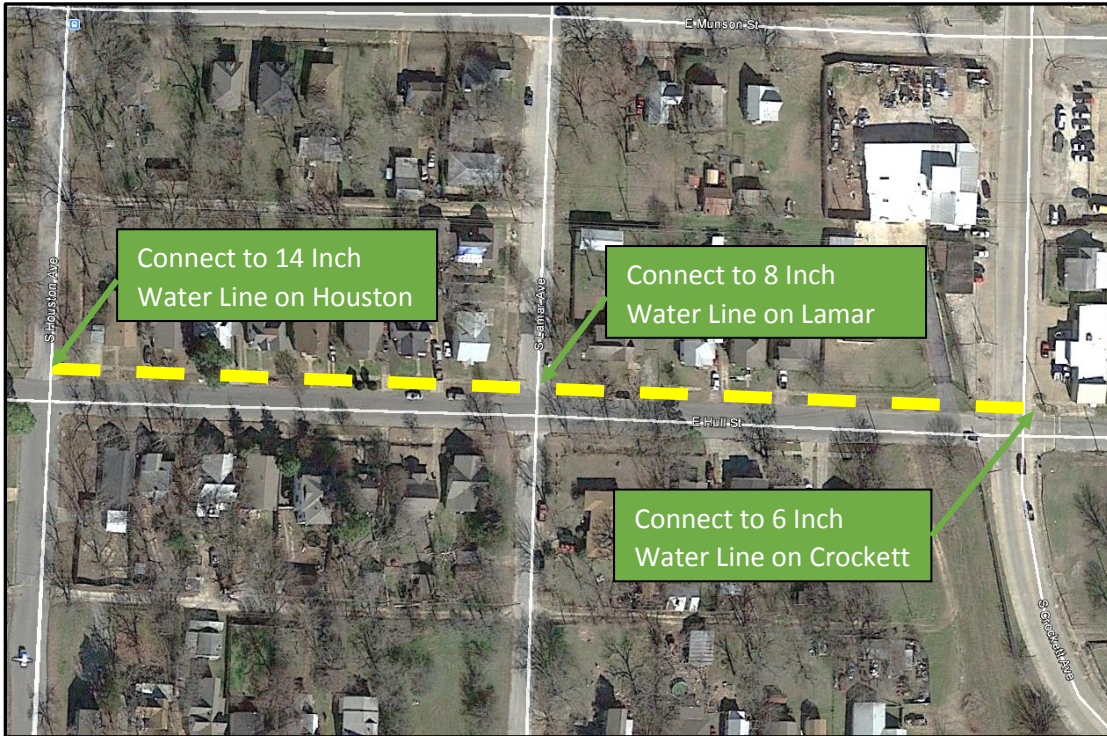
EAST MONTEREY WATER LINE (5th to 7th)
