FM 1417 12-Inch Water Line (F.M. 120 to F.M. 996)

PROJECT OVERVIEW This project involves the extension of a new 12-inch water line from FM 120 to FM 996 on the west side of FM 1417. This line will provide a vital link between the Parkdale System and North Texas Regional Airport Water Systems, both of which supply water to the City of Pottsboro. Primary benefits include tying both Pottsboro connections and the Caterpillar complex over to the larger Parkdale system, while reserving more of the smaller NTRA distribution system for future growth at the airport.
